




### Highlights of this route

You can set off as soon as you arrive at Yamaguchi Ube Airport. This route lets you relax and experience the natural scenery even though you stay in the city.








**UBE** Biennale

Approximately 200 sculptures are displayed throughout the city, with the majority at the UBE Biennale outdoor sculpture exhibition's sculpture hill in Tokiwa Park.



### Tokiwa Zoo

This zoo is the first one in Japan to consist entirely of "habitat exhibits" that showcase animals displayed in their natural ecological habitats, acting as they would in the wild. inclines and declines, this course is recommended even to beginners.




